



GRANT GIVING POLICY

All Grants are subject to the following conditions:

1. Applications must include:
 - a. a completed application form;
 - b. required documents, dependent on type of grant being applied for (see below 'Required Documents' table)
2. We cannot consider incomplete applications. Applications made which do not include the required documents will be considered incomplete and will be rejected.
3. Grants (apart from Bereavement and Bone Marrow Transplant/Gene Therapy) are awarded in consideration of household income and savings. To qualify for a grant, both of the following must apply:
 - a. You must have less than £6,000 in savings if you are single, or less than £8,000 as a couple or family
 - b. You must have a low total income after you have paid rent, mortgage and council tax. We allow a weekly income of £170 for a single person, £289 for a couple or household of two people, £85 for each child, and £119 for each additional adult. *Please note: Personal Independence Payments (PIP), Disability Living Allowance (DLA) and Attendance Allowance (AA) are not counted in our calculations.*
 - c. If you're applying from overseas, please see our overseas section
4. The maximum amount any one family may receive in grants over a twelve-month period is £1,000 unless agreed by the Trustee Board for exceptional circumstances.
5. The decision to approve or reject a Grant request is final.
6. Complete Grant applications will be considered by Alex TLC and processed within 21 days.
7. Successful applicants will be sent a short survey to complete following receipt of the grant to gather feedback on its use and impact. This information will be used anonymously to promote and develop the Alex TLC grants programme.
8. Grant applicants' details will automatically be added to our database. If you wish to opt out of receiving communications from us, please contact us.

DATA PROTECTION

Information provided to Alex TLC through a Grant Application form will be kept secure and will not be shared with third parties, in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#).

Additional documents will be required, and conditions will need to be met dependent on Grant type. Please see below for further requirements and conditions.

BEREAVEMENT

A copy of the death certificate stating genetic leukodystrophy as cause of death or contributory factor is required in order to qualify for this grant. The family can choose how they would like to use the grant. Maximum grant £300.00, payable to the family.

BONE MARROW TRANSPLANT/GENE THERAPY

A copy of a letter from the Consultant confirming that a Bone Marrow Transplant is being undertaken in order to treat a genetic leukodystrophy. This is intended to help with any extra expense connected to having BMT for a genetic leukodystrophy and is subject to Alex TLC Grant giving policy. Maximum grant £300.00, payable to family.

EQUIPMENT

Grants can only be given for equipment due to a disability need and will not be given for other items unless they are specifically modified for a disability caused by a genetic leukodystrophy. Grants will not be paid for general repairs/maintenance for vehicles unless they are essential for mobility where public transport cannot be accessed, this must be confirmed in writing by a medical professional.

We require an Invoice/estimate for goods before they are ordered, and we will confirm in writing the amount we will pay either towards the equipment or the full amount. We take no responsibility for items purchased and they must be purchased under the recommendation/guidance of a medical professional. Any request for equipment will only be considered on production of a letter from a medical professional confirming benefit and that this item is not available on the NHS or via Social Services. **Please note we only pay direct to the provider/supplier and do not pay retrospectively, with no exceptions.**

TREATMENT

We require an invoice/estimate for treatment needs plus letter from medical professional confirming benefit and that this treatment is not available on the NHS or that the NHS waiting list is excessive. Grants can only be given for treatments not accessible on the NHS or where the waiting list is considered excessive, as confirmed by a medical professional. **Please note we only pay direct to the provider/supplier and do not pay retrospectively, with no exceptions.**

CARE

We can provide a grant for care when it is not available through social services or through NHS funded care. **Please note we only pay direct to the provider/supplier and do not pay retrospectively, with no exceptions.**

OVERSEAS GRANTS

We are happy to consider grants from individuals outside of the UK. We will assess applications on an individual basis as we appreciate that different countries have variable health and support infrastructures and cost of living. As with UK grants, we will require bank statements and proof of income and outgoings alongside other required evidence. **Please note we only pay direct to the provider/supplier and do not pay retrospectively, with no exceptions.**

OTHER GRANT REQUESTS
